Our Indah collection, meaning "beautiful" in Indonesian, is inspired by traditional Indonesian folk art and the simplicity of natural elements. Each design is painstakingly carved onto antiqued reclaimed teak wood in exquisite, multi-dimensional relief.

#### Product Usage Recommendations

- Suitable for indoor vertical applications.
- Not suitable for wet areas.
- Outdoor use subject to moderate climates only.
- Wood will weather to a silver gray if installed outdoors.
- Wood will expand and contract depending on climate and humidity.

#### Installation and Maintenance Guidelines

- Install per manufacturer's instructions.
- Allow tiles to air-dry out of box for 7 days prior to installation.
- All cuts or drilled holes should be sealed.
- Use damp towel or toothbrush to clean tiles.
- Always inspect material prior to installation; installed material can not be accepted for return or credit.

**Finishes:** unfinished, natural with wax, medium french polish, dark french polish, whitewash
